WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?

(EDITOR'S NOTE: The following is a tract used by Bro. Frank Carr while a missionary in Japan. It was sent to me from Sis. Mary Dillard of Nashville, TN and was previously printed in a 1964 issue of THE BAP-TIST PROGRESSOR, edited by Bo. Paul Oldham in Lafayette, TN.)

In life today there are many problems, and we can hear questions about material things of all kinds. But it would seem that thousands of people were forgetting their Eternal Souls, Because they are leaving off the most important question. And that is, What must I do to be saved?—But, although we don't hear this question asked by everybody we meet, it is truly on the heart of every unsaved person upon the earth, for indeed this can not be forgotten.

This is not a new question—It has been asked by people through all ages. In the 16th Chapter of the Book of Acts, we find a jailor com-

ing humble and asking this question.

At that time, Christians were being badly persecuted, and Paul and Silas, after they had been beaten, were thrust into the inner prison. But by no means were they discouraged. At midnight they prayed and sang praises unto God. And God heard them, and His power came on the scene, and He sent a great earthquake, and immediately all the prison doors were opened, and everyone's bands were loosed. The keeper seeing the power of God, and realizing that salvation is real, came trembling and fell down before Paul and Silas, and asked,—"What must I do to be Saved?" Acts 16:30. The answer by these two men of God was,—"Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved—" Acts 16:31.

The answer to this question is still the same today. As I have already stated, this is not a new question, and it doesn't have a new answer. It has been the same through all ages. God is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

Now to be saved, means to be born again. And Jesus said, "-Verily, verily, I say unto thee, except a man be born again, he can not see the kingdom of God." John 3:3. It means to be born of God, to be freed from sin, and to become one of God's children. "For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus." Galatians 3:26.

We are saved by grace through faith in Christ, and Jesus Christ is

God's only begotten Son. God loved the world, and being not willing that any should perish, He gave His Darling Son, that the world through Him might have Everlasting Life. "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him, should not perish, but have Everlasting Life." John 3:16.

Not only are we saved through Christ, but there is no other way. "Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth, for I am God, and there is none else." Isaiah 45:22. Neither is there salvation in any other, for there is none other name under Heaven give among men, whereby we must be saved. Acts 4:12. If we could be saved another way, then the death of Christ on the cross would be in vain, but there is no other way. There is no salvation in Buddha, Shintoism, nor Mohammed—For Jesus said, "-I am the way, the truth, and the life, no man cometh unto the Father but by me." John 14:6.

In the eyes of God there are only two classes of people. One is the saved redeemed children of God. The other one is the unsaved, sinners, which are on the broad way that leads to hell and torment.

Jesus doesn't love sin, but He truly loves the sinner, and He is such a wonderful Saviour. He loved the sin cursed world, and He came and gave His life and shed His own precious blood on the rugged cross of Calvary, to save all-whosoever will come, repenting and believing. Yes, He is calling. He is ready, and He is more than able.

Once again let me say, to be saved means, to have a change of heart, to be redeemed from sin, to pass from spiritual death unto Eternal Life, and to be raised from the power and darkness of the devil, to walk in the glorious light of the Son of God-Yes, and to be at peace with God.

Now, all of this comes by true repentance, and faith in our Lord Jesus Christ. To repent means to be sorrow for sin. to feel pain and sorrow on the ac-

count of it, to give it up, nd to resist the devil-and the devil will flee from you. "Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw nigh to God and He will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands ye sinners; and purify your hearts ye double minded. Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep; let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness. Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He shall lift you up." James 4:7-10.

Jesus Christ was promised by God the Father, prophecied by the prophets, foretold by the Angel, born of a virgin, laid in a manger, praised by the heavenly host, worshipped by the shepherds and He committed no sin. Even Pilate said, "-I find no fault in this man." Luke 23:4.

1802 ARTICLES OF FAITH

(EDITOR'S NOTE: The following was submitted from the J. M. Pendleton Baptist Library. El Bethel was organized about 1796 and is now out of existence, but many middle Tn. churches trace their history through her. As were many Baptist Churches of that day, El Bethel leaned to Calvinism as indicated by articles 3, 5, and 7.)

RECORD OF EL BETHEL BAPTIST CHURCH EAST STATION CAMP, TENNESSEE

Respectfully copied in 1959 from the original Church Book by RUTH REIDLING HAHM

Descendant of the Mays, Hodges, Suttles, Reddicks and Taylors, who were beloved brethren in this church.

ARTICLES OF OUR PROFESSION OF RELIGION AS AGREED TO AND RECEIVED IN CONFERENCE AT JULY MEETING, 1802, TO BE APPROVED BY EACH MEMBER

- (1) We believe in the ONE only true and living God, and there are Three Persons in the Godhead, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost.
- (2) We believe that the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are the word of God, and the only rule of faith and practice.
- (3) We believe in the Doctrine of Eternal Election.
- (4) We believe the Doctrine of Original Sin.
- (5) We believe in man's impotency to recover himself from the fallen state he is in by nature, by his own free will ability.
- (6) We believe that sinners are justified in the sight of God only by the imputed righteousness of Christ.
- (7) We believe that God's elect shall be called, converted, regenerated and sanctified by the Holy Spirit.
- (8) We believe the saints will persevere in grace, and never fall finally away.
- (9) We believe that Baptism and the Lord's Supper are ordinances of Christ Jesus, and that true believers are subjects of these ordinances. We believe the true mode of baptism is by immersion.
- (10) We believe in the resurrection of the dead; a general judgment.
- (11) We believe the punishment of the wicked will be everlasting, and the joys of the righteous eternal.
- (12) We believe that no ministers have the right to the administration of the ordinances but such as are called, and come under the imposition of hands by the presbytery.

One of the most foolish things a warrior can do is to go to battle without first knowing his enemy. Satan has planted many of his best agents among us. Let's expose a few of them:


First is Chronic Complainer. He is silent only when the church is idle.


