It confuses the sinners when that same good lady hardly speaks to them the Sunday after the revival closes. How do you feel when going to a revival service and hear the preacher compassionately empty himself in sermon to the unsaved, only to discover that as far as anyone knew, there were no sinners in the crowd. The revival had just been in progress for a week. The church members were having a great time singing praises to God, and being fed on the eternal truths of God's Word, but would return home each evening to flip on the television or read the paper until bedtime. These same people will say to

each other, "wonder what's wrong," or "we need to change pastors" or "call another evangelist next time." Then one will say, "it's the fulfillment of the Scriptures." That's old faithful for all the

## THE BIBLE PLAN

The Plan of Salvation has been the same in all dispensations. Those who believe in salvation by ceremony believe, that as the necessarily ceremonies change from one dispensation to another, the plan of salvation changes also. These ceremonialists think that the people who lived under the Old Testament law were saved by keeping that law. Since these ceremonies have been done away, and we now have baptism and the Lord's Supper, they think, of course, that we are saved by being baptized and partaking of the Lord's Supper. There are others who think that the people in Old Testament time were saved by observing the law of Moses. But when Christ came to earth, they think, all that was changed to salvation by grace under the present dispensation. The truth of the matter is that people have been saved by GRACE in all dispensations, and the Law never saved anyone. Law condemns but does not save! The law showed us two things, the need of a Saviour and in shadow or type showed how this Saviour saves.

Paul tells us in Hebrews 10:4, "it was not possible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins." Those Old Testament ceremonies did not save, but they pointed to the Saviour. They were like signboards on a roadside. The signboard points to a city or town, but it will never carry one to that town or city. Follow the directions of the signboard and you will reach the place toward which the signboard points. One would never get anywhere trying to ride a signboard. So those who observed the ceremonies of the Old Testament had a clear revelation of what Jesus would do

for the sinner, but the ceremonies were never able nor intended to save the sinner. They were shadows of the work of Christ. It is a great mistake to take the shadow instead of the substance. There are some who think that all the Jews were born in a saved or covenant relationship, and that since all Jews were born children of God it was necessary for the Jew to fall from grace, so to speak, before he could be lost. Such an idea confuses the Jews as a nation, and the Jews as individuals. The Jewish nation as such was indeed God's people. But each individual Jew repented for himself, believed for himself, and must be regenerated for himself just exactly as all of us must now do in order to be saved.

John the Baptist said to the Jews who came to his baptism, "O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee the wrath to come? Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance, and think not to say within yourselves, we have Abraham to our father. For I say unto you that God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham." (Matt. 3:7-9)

Thus we see that being children of Abraham did not help them in their personal salvation, but only benefited them as a nation. When Nicodemus came to Jesus for instructions (John 3), he told him plainly "marvel not that I say unto thee, ye must be born again." Did Nicodemus, a moral and upright Jew, need regeneration? Jesus said he did! If Nicodemus must be born again, it follows that all Jews needed the new birth. If they all needed the new birth, then they were certainly not born in a saved or covenant relationship with God. They were not natural children of God. It has been true all the way back. Most assuredly it has been the same way all the way because Jesus said to Nicodemus, "Art thou a master of Israel and knowest not these things? We speak that we do know, and testify that we have seen. If I have told you earthly things and ye believed not, how shall ve believe if I tell you of heavenly things?"

If this language does not mean that it was surprising to Jesus for a teacher (master) in Israel to be unlearned about the new birth, it teaches nothing. The only way Nicodemus could have known anything about the new birth was by the Old Testament teachings, and by experience. If the Old Testament taught the new birth, then it is no new thing.

When we fail to personally further the gospel of Christ to the "highways and hedges", we are taking the same practical stand as our "hardshell" Baptist brethren take doctrinally. They are openly opposed to missions, and perhaps a few of them belong to our churches.

As long as we are living to serve a living Christ and proclaim a life giving gospel, we should travel to sinners and point them to the Christ of Calvary.

#### **First Things First**

"Go and teach (make disciples) all nations" Every church should be engaged in going after the lost, first and continually. Don't go on your own, but go with Christ and a prayer in your heart. Can you imagine how it would affect your service next Sunday, if half the members influenced a sinner each to attend?

The pastor some feel need to be replaced might come alive and be a flame of fire in directing the unsaved toward the precious, spotless Lamb of God.

It is my heart's desire that none of you yet believe that sinners must hear a preacher from the pulpit in order for God's Holy Spirit to convict them of their sins. God wills that every born-again believer in Christ be a missionary in leading someone to the Lord. You may not be able to give a cent to the church, you may not be qualified to teach Sunday School, play the musical instruments, serve as deacon, but, if you have been delivered from the bondage of Satan and sin by God's redeeming grace and united with the Lord's church, you surely must be able and willing to relate to all others what God hath done for you.
